

RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES

As a major research institution, the University of Chicago offers numerous opportunities for students to engage in research. In addition to the listings in this section, see the independent study and research courses listed in individual concentration sections. College Research Opportunities Program (CROP). The *CROP Directory* lists faculty research projects in a wide range of departments and schools throughout the University, including the Medical Center. International Traveling Research Fellowship. The International Traveling Research Fellowship supports summer research outside the United States on a project leading to a B.A. thesis. Use of a language other than English, preferably one studied at the College, is a prerequisite for this award. Margaret C. Annan Undergraduate Award in Writing. The Annan prize provides a summer stipend to support a student engaged in a writing project between the third and fourth years. Visit the Office of the College Dean, HM 241, or scholarships-college.uchicago.edu.

Richter Fund. The Richter Fund supports research expenses up to \$1,000 (excluding living expenses) and offers grants of up to \$800 for college students who wish to pursue an internship with a not-for-profit organization.
